How to apply for teacher training

Applications for initial teacher training (ITT) courses starting in 2016 are made via a system administered by the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS).

If you are ready to make your application, you can do so through [UCAS Teacher Training](#), the new teacher training portal through which you can apply for all postgraduate ITT.

Before making your application you should register with the Department for Education (DfE) online, or on freephone 0800 389 2500.
