- Children break up from school on Friday 25th May and return on Monday 4th June
- Reminder: from Monday 4th June, there will be no access to the main school office or the hall due to building works. All money, letters etc should be sent into class with your child. Alternatively, there will be a secure postbox situated at the main staff entrance (halfway between Nursery and the school office) for parents to put things in for the attention of office staff. This door will be manned by staff between 8.30 am - 8.45 am. Parents coming to school during the day will need to ring the doorbell for attention. *All money sent in to school should be in an envelope (available from the school office), clearly marked with child's name, class, amount enclosed etc. Please try to send the correct amount in as we struggle for change. Children should hand envelopes in to the class teacher during registration time.*
- Please make sure children have water bottles and sun hats in school. Sun cream should be applied to children before they come to school.
- Children will be on the field for the majority of playtimes/lunchtimes during this term - we need a letter from parents for any child not allowed to play on the field due to allergies. Any children who suffer from hayfever should have their medication before they come to school. We can apply allergy eye drops to children in school before they go out at lunchtime - parents would need to provide the drops and complete a medical consent form.
