Tell classmates about your qualities, interests, hobbies etc. and why you will make a good class representative. Be ready to answer any possible questions from your audience in class.
- Produce a poster to display in the hall to persuade your class members to vote for you (by hand or computer). This should be handed into Miss Manning (KS2) or Mrs Vawer (KS1) by Friday 29th September at the very latest. Parents may help you prepare the presentation and poster (but not do it for you!).
