The Ancient Mayans

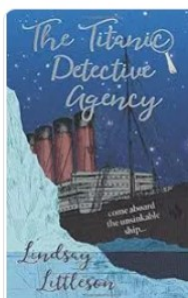
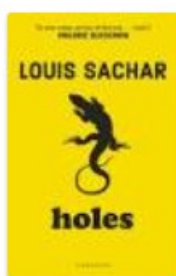


In Literacy we are studying:
